Culinary Team Canada Pastry Chef, Michelle Brown is in a strong battle with cancer. Our prayers are sent out to her and family!

Michelle and her 2 sons were the pastry department that worked closely across borders with Culinary Team Canada for 16 months leading up to the Olympics.

These types of relationships between team members become strong and last forever.

An email addressed to Chef JD Braid from Michelle's Son Bennet:

I wish this was under better circumstances but I wanted to let you know she was taken off treatment on Monday. She was transported to hospice this afternoon and most likely has a few days remaining.

As you know, she was diagnosed last June with a very aggressive form of myeloma. She knew it was going to be a very difficult battle. There were plenty of highs and lows but ultimately this was the only thing stronger than her.

She had a very strong week and a half after her birthday where her numbers were great and she was full of energy being her regular self. That gave us another chance at getting the stemcell transplant but a few days later, the chemo was too much for her body to handle.

She had been unable to speak and do much on her own since early February. But throughout her battle she was constantly planning on eventually getting back to teaching and was excited to be part of the team again in Luxembourg, even if just for support. She loved working with you guys. And always joked in the beginning of covid that if competing in Germany with you all was the last thing she did, then she ended on a high note.

We're all with her now and she's being kept comfortable for her remaining days.

Obviously we hoped it didn't come to this and the last week accelerated it tremendously but we've had time to prepare.

Her wishes were to be cremated and have her ashes scattered in a couple of places.

There will be a memorial sometime in the future the coming weeks in Waco and another around April in New York.

She accomplished a lot and had a great run. We know she could go for another 100 years if she could.
